**Addendum No. 2 to the Tender for Charter Hire of
54 Vessels on “As-is-where-is” basis**

1. The intending bidders in the Techno-Commercial Bid are required to indicate as to how many number of each type of vessels viz. Tugs, Self Propelled Carriers (SPC) and Dumb Barges (DB) they want to bid for in the e-auction. The amount of EMD for different types of vessels in descending order is furnished herewith. Accordingly, bidders are to submit EMD for those many number of vessels of each type, taking the highest (H-1) EMD, 2nd Highest (H-2) EMD and so on in the descending order as per EMD details in e-auction catalogue.
2. It may be further noted that the prospective bidders are not required to necessarily mention the names of the vessels (unless they so desire) they intend to bid for but only required to mention the number of vessels in each category/type. For example, if a prospective bidder is willing to take over say 2 nos. Tugs, 2 nos. Self Propelled Carriers (SPCs) and 6 nos. Dumb Barges (DBs), then the total EMD would be determined as follows :
